All cast members (EXCEPT SHOOTING STARS, 9:00AM SATURDAY BALLET CLASS AND 10:00AM SATURDAY BALLET CLASS) are to arrive at 9:00am, Shooting Stars and 9:00am and 10:00am ballet members please arrive at 12:00pm. Everyone is to wear full stage makeup as indicated on our blog page, with hair neatly groomed in a low bun using hairspray and grips to secure any wispy bits and fringes must be off the face. Boys need to have their hair groomed appropriately.

Please bring your Starbrite t-shirt separately on a named coat hanger so we can keep this neat and tidy for the show. Arrive in your black jazz shoes, black jazz pants (or black leggings) please ensure they are all clearly labelled. A dressing gown, zip up jumper or onesie covers up students as well as keeping them warm when they are not on stage.

All other costumes and accessories that you are providing must be clearly labelled in separate costume carriers with the scene number, dance number and child's name in capital letters.

These will then be placed straight on to the costume rails provided. DO NOT BRING YOUR CHILD'S COSTUME IN ONE COSTUME BAG. THE BACK STAGE AREA IS SET UP IN DANCE AND STUDENT ORDER.

You will need to bring with you your spare makeup, hairspray, comb/brush, hair grips, plenty of fluids, snacks and packed lunch as there will be nowhere on site to purchase these items.

Please note that only crew and fully licenced chaperones will be allowed in the venue past the sign in point with the students.

Parents and carers will NOT be allowed in the changing area or holding rooms at any time.

Please drop off and collect students again from the main entrance lobby. We recommend arriving at the exact drop off time to avoid queuing outside in the cold/rain. Students will be signed in and out by Miss Kirstie. Please note that this can take time, but it is important for the safety of the children. We ask that only **one** parent or carer collects their child to minimise the amount of people in a small area, with family members waiting outside the building.

If your child is being collected by another parent, then it is your responsibility to communicate this to us prior to the day of the performances so the correct paperwork can be completed by the parent.



To ensure that the day runs smoothly and on time could we please ask that all drop of and collection times are adhered to.
